We asked and you responded! The Koognaasewin Project Team wants to send a huge shoutout to everyone who completed our Community Survey.

The month-long survey campaign was held online, in-person and by mail-in, and we're excited to report that we received over 500 responses!! Most responses were completed online with 393 responses, but in-person and mail-in surveys accounted for over 160 responses! We learned that we have more work to do to get the word out about the Koognaasewin initiative!

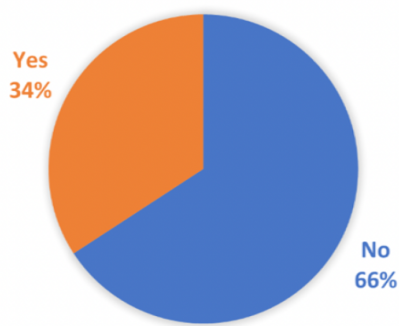
Approximately 68% of respondents said that they were somewhat familiar or had little familiarity at all about the child welfare system. You told us you're keen on us using social media, email, community meetings/gatherings, info packages and community mailouts to share information about the project, and most respondents would welcome online engagement (i.e., via Zoom). Most respondents who took our survey lived in their community. The survey included two open-ended questions asking respondents to tell us their thoughts about what child well-being means to them, and about the child and family services they are aware of or use in their community or regionally.



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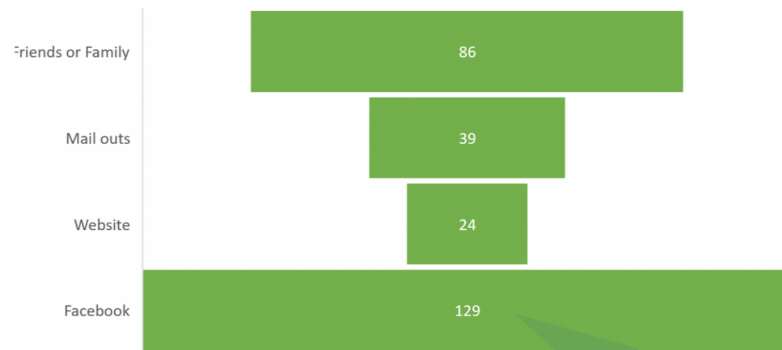


1. Do you know about the Koognaasewin (Child Well-Being Law) Initiative?

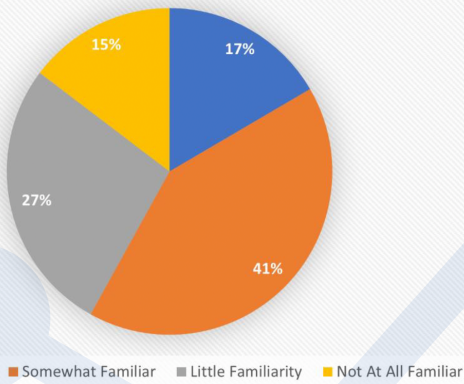


2. Where have you heard about the Koognaasewin Project?
